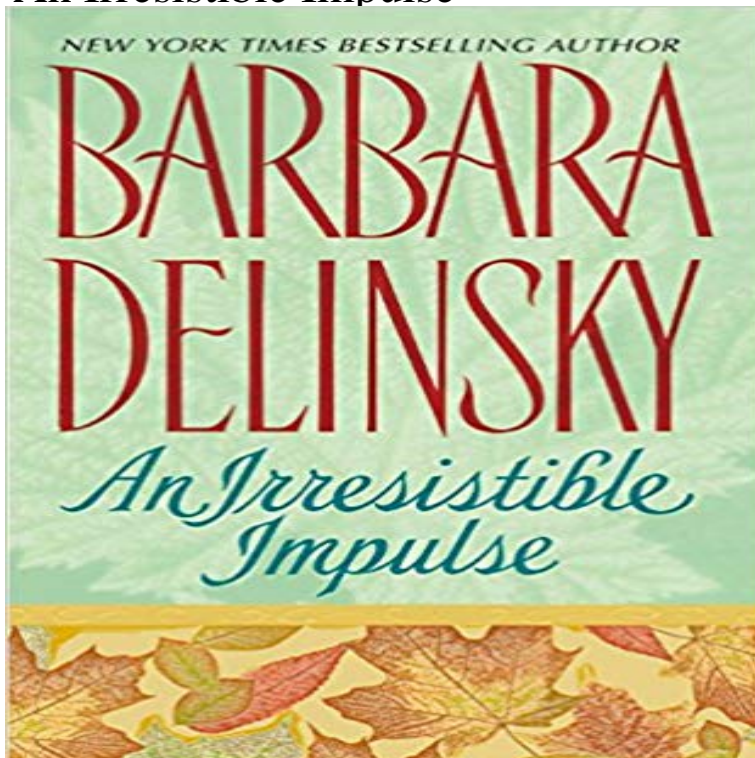


An Irresistible Impulse
